<i>Records show he served and went overseas with 9th East Lancashire Regt and later transferred to the Labour Corps.</i>			
<i>The 9th Battalion East Lancashire Regiment was part of 65th Brigade, 22nd Division. The Division moved to France on September 1915. At the end of October 1915 they moved to Salonika.</i>			
<i>They were involved in the following battles in the Salonika campaign.</i>			
<i>Battle of Horeshoe Hill 10th-18th August 1916.</i>			
<i>Battle of Machukovo 13th-14th September 1916.</i>			
<i>Battle of Doiran 24th-25th April & 8th-9th May 1917.</i>			
<i>Battle of Doiran 18th-19th September 1918.</i>			
<i>Unfortunately as his service record is not available it is not possible to ascertain which actions he was involved in. His transfer to the Labour Corps would indicate that he was either wounded or sick and not fit for Front Line service.</i>			
<i>His service number allocated with the Labour Corps indicates that he first served in 9th Infantry Labour Company, Liverpool Regt. In 1917 this unit became 74th Labour Company.</i>
